



For this design you will need –

Tools -

Floral knife or cutters



Supplies -

1 - 6” glass cylinder vase

Fresh, clean water

Floralife Flower Food

1 - 2 cups of black stones



Fresh Flowers -

1 bunch of Alstroemeria

1 wide green leaf such as Aspidistra leaf



Instructions –

1. Choose container. Add stones, and water with Floralife Flower Food.
2. Choose leaf for vase interior. If leaf is too wide, split in half lengthwise.
3. Wrap one section of the leaf around fingers in a circle and insert into the vase.
4. Strip excess foliage from Alstroemeria stems.
5. Cut each stem with a good, sharp cut at approximately the same length. Drop each stem into the vase of water, being careful to keep stems inside the circle of leaf.
6. Spray flowers with Floralife’s anti-transpirant Finishing Touch to hydrate and increase longevity.
